**ORDER VACATING PRESIDING JUDGES' AUGUST 5, 2021 ORDER  
ESTABLISHING A STATEWIDE DISTRICT COURT EVICTION PROTOCOL**

On August 26, 2021, the United States Supreme Court issued a decision in *Alabama Association of Realtors, et al, v. Department of Health and Human Services, et al.*,<sup>1</sup> vacating the moratorium on certain residential evictions established on August 3, 2021 by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. In light of the Supreme Court's decision, the August 5, 2021 Presiding Judges' order adopting statewide eviction protocols is vacated.
