This sculpture of three welded steel figures reflects the ageless ceremonial dance of the Barrow Eskimos. The dancing masks are styled from 19<sup>th</sup> century masks. The dress of the figures is contemporary. The background is acrylic paint on canvas, suggesting the skyline above the arctic tundra. It also includes an etching designed from Eskimo pre-historic art objects.
