

How to Submit Audio/Video Files for Motions to the Alaska Court System

TrueFiling does not support any audio or video submission. Filers can use [ZendTo](#) to send court-related audio/videos files securely and efficiently for case types that are part of eFiling.

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Complete the **Notice of Filing Audio or Video Attachment Electronically** form ([TF-199](#)) and submit via TrueFiling.

This form is used to notify the court of your audio/video submission related to your case.

2. **Upload your files via ZendTo.** Visit the [Alaska ZendTo](#) website to securely upload your audio or video.

Before uploading, verify the file format is acceptable. ZendTo only allows the following type of audio and video file format:

3. **Identify the Correct Court Email:**

Use the [Directory of Email Addresses by Court](#) to find the appropriate email address for your specific court.

4. **Submit Your Files.**

The Alaska Court System will receive both the TF-199 form and the uploaded files via ZendTo.
