PUBLIC COMPUTER USE POLICY

The Alaska State Court Law Library provides legal research computers to access government and other legal resources available on the Internet. The Internet has a wealth of resources, and the library cannot be responsible for its content. You should critically evaluate the information you find for accuracy, completeness, and currency. You may encounter offensive material.

User Responsibilities:

Please comply with the following Public Computer Use Guidelines or you may lose your computer privileges. Library staff can provide basic assistance only.

- Library computers are to be used for legal research only. You may not use library computers to access anything not connected to legal research.
- If someone is waiting to use the computer, you are limited to 30 minutes of use.
- Video streaming of non-legal material is not allowed. It may interfere with vital court functions, such as CourtView.
- Provided the computer is set up to allow it, you may download freely to your own drive or e-mail library material to yourself, so long as the material is in the public domain or is non-copyrighted.
- You may not print anything the library owns in hard copy, and you may only print 20 pages total per day.
- You may not use library equipment for any illegal activity, nor may you use our equipment to offend, harass, intimidate, or threaten anyone.
- You may not alter the configuration of or otherwise damage our equipment.
- You may not use more than one computer at a time.
- No more than two people may share a computer station.
