Amending Civil Rule 6(c) and Criminal Rule 40(e) concerning extra time when service is by mail.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Civil Rule 6(c) is amended to provide:

(c) Additional Time After Service by Mail. Whenever a party has the right or is required to do some act or take some proceedings within a prescribed period after the service of a notice or other paper, other than documents served under Civil Rule 4(h), upon the party and the notice or paper is served upon the party by mail, three days shall added to the prescribed period. be This paragraph does not extend any time period calculated from a date under Civil Rule 58.1.

2. Criminal Rule 40(e) is amended to provide:

(e) Additional Time After Service by Mail. Whenever a party has the right or is required to do an act within a prescribed period after the service of a notice or other paper upon <u>the party</u> [HIM] and the notice or other paper is served upon <u>the party</u> [HIM] by mail, 3 days shall be added to the prescribed Supreme Court Order No. <u>1007</u> Effective Date: <u>January 15, 1990</u> Page 2

> period. This paragraph does not extend any time period calculated from a date under Criminal Rule 32.3.
