7. The fourth of July, known as Independence Day
8. The first Monday in September, known as  
Labor Day
9. The third Monday of October, known as Alaska Day
10. The fourth Monday in October, known as  
Veteran's Day
11. The fourth Thursday in November, known as  
Thanksgiving Day
12. The 25th of December, known as Christmas Day
13. Every day designated by public proclamation by  
the President of the United States or the  
Governor of the state as a legal holiday.

- (13) Every day designated by public proclamation by the President of the United States or the Governor of the State as a legal holiday.




