ORDER NO. 1049

Amending Criminal Rule 32(e)
concerning sentencing referrals
to three-judge panel.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Criminal Rule 32(e)(7) is amended to provide:

(7) If the three-judge sentencing panel imposes sentence on the defendant, proceedings relating to sentence modification under Criminal Rule 35(a) shall be assigned to the three-judge panel sitting at the time such action is ready for decision. All other post-sentencing proceedings shall be assigned to the judge who referred the matter to the three-judge panel for consideration. The referring judge may impose any sentence which the three-judge panel would be empowered to impose, except that the referring judge may not reduce a sentence imposed by the three-judge panel.


