Amending Appellate Rule 608
concerning sentence appeals.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Appellate Rule 608 is amended to provide:

Rule 608. Sentence Appeal.

A sentence appeal to the superior court is governed by Rule 215. That rule will in case of inconsistency prevail over Part Six of these rules, except that (1) the notice of appeal must be filed in the superior court rather than the district court; and (2) as provided by Rule 604, the record on appeal consists of the entire district court record and designation of the record is not required. It is only necessary to file with the court the original memorandum on appeal; no additional copies are required.


