Amending Criminal Rule 25(d) concerning peremptory challenges.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Criminal Rule 25(d) is amended to provide:

(2) <u>Procedure.</u> [WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER A JUDGE IS ASSIGNED THE CASE FOR THE FIRST TIME, A] <u>A</u> party may exercise the party's right to a change of judge by filing a "Notice of Change of Judge" signed by counsel, if any, stating the name of the judge to be changed. <u>The notice shall</u> <u>neither specify grounds nor be accompanied</u> by an affidavit. The notice of change of judge is timely if filed within five days after notice that the case has been assigned to a specific judge.
