
Amending Alaska Bar Rule 5,

IT IS ORDERED:


1. Bar Rule 5(b) is amended to provide:
 - (b) Within 60 days after completion of the requirements stated in subparagraphs (a)(1), (2) and (6) of Section 1 of this Rule [RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF PASSAGE OF THE BAR EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATION TO THE SUPREME COURT FOR ADMISSION, OR WITHIN 60 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF PASSAGE OF THE MULTISTATE PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY EXAMINATION, WHICHEVER COMES LATER], an applicant must file with the Alaska Bar Association a registration card, in the form provided by the Board, formally accepting membership in the Association and admission to the practice of law in Alaska.






