Amending Civil Rule 69(d)
concerning execution after five
years.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Civil Rule 69(d) is amended to provide:

(d) Execution After Five Years. Whenever a period of five years shall elapse [AFTER THE ENTRY OF A JUDGMENT] without an execution being issued on a judgment [THEREON], no execution shall issue except on order of the court in the following manner:
