

IN THE SUPREME COURT FOR THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 1105

Amending CINA Rule 10(b) and
Delinquency Rule 14(b)
concerning notice of liability
for child support.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Subparagraph (1) of CINA Rule 10(b) is amended to provide:

(1) *Opening Address.* The court shall determine whether all parties have received copies of the petition and understand its contents and shall advise the parties of the nature of the proceedings and possible disposition. In addition, the court shall advise the parties of the possibility of a temporary custody or supervision order pending adjudication and final deposition[.], and that the parents may be liable for child support payments if the child is placed outside the home at any time during the proceeding.

2. Subparagraph (1) of Delinquency Rule 14(b) is amended to provide:

(1) *Opening Address.* The court shall ensure that all parties have received copies of the petition and understand its contents. The court shall advise the parties of the nature of the proceedings and the possible disposition that may occur. In addition, the court shall advise the parties of the possibility of temporary

detention or placement outside the home pending final disposition[.], and that the parents may be liable for child support payments if the child is placed outside the home at any time during the proceeding.
