Amending Rule 21,  
Supreme Court Rules

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 21, Rules of the Supreme Court, is amended  
by the addition of a new subdivision (1) to read as follows:

(1) Consolidation of Sentence  
Appeals with Regular Appeals. An  
appeal of a sentence on the ground  
that the sentence is excessive or  
too lenient shall be consolidated  
with an appeal based upon other  
grounds. Upon consolidation, the  
procedure for perfecting an appeal  
on other grounds shall govern.
