ORDER NO. 1157

Amending Appellate Rules 212
and 605 to correct a rule
reference.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Subparagraph (2) of Appellate Rule 212(a) is amended to provide:

(2) *Number of Copies.* A single copy of each brief accompanied by proof of service must be filed with the clerk on or before the date the brief is due. The brief will be reviewed and returned to counsel for duplication and binding. Within ten days thereafter, 15 copies of each duplicated brief in civil appeals must be filed with the clerk and two copies shall be served on each party. Thirteen copies of each duplicated brief in criminal cases must be filed with the clerk and two copies shall be served on each party. The clerk may specify a different number of copies than required by this rule.

2. Subparagraph (4) of Appellate Rule 605(a) is amended to provide:

(4) the filing of a single copy of the brief with proof of service is sufficient, without the necessity of duplication as provided by Rule 212(a)(2).




