Amending Appellate Rule 503  
concerning copies of motions.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Appellate Rule 503(c) is amended to provide:

(c) **Filing and Service.** The original of all motions and responses must be filed with the clerk, together with proof of service on all other parties. ~~Two copies of a motion to the supreme court or a response to such a motion shall be submitted with the original.~~ The following copies must be submitted with the original:

(1) five copies of a motion that must be decided by the full supreme court pursuant to Appellate Rule 503(g) or a response to such motion;

(2) three copies of a motion that must be decided by the full court of appeals pursuant to Appellate Rule 503(g) or a response to such motion;

(3) two copies of all other motions or responses.
