Amending Criminal Rule 32.5
concerning notification of
right to appeal.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Criminal Rule 32.5(a) is amended to provide:

A person convicted of a crime after trial shall be advised by the judge or magistrate:

(a) that the person has the right to appeal from the judgment of conviction within 30 days (or 15 days in appeals from the district court made under Appellate Rule 217) from the date shown in the clerk's certificate of distribution on the judgment appealed from by filing a notice of appeal with the clerk of the appellate courts;
