Amending Rule 29
Rules of Administration

IT IS ORDERED:

The Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts
are amended as set out below:

Rule 29, Rules Governing the Administration of
All Courts. Is amended to read as follows:

(a) Regular Sessions. Regular sessions of the
superior courts shall be held in each judicial district
at the places hereinafter designated commencing on
a date to be announced by order of the court;

(1) First Judicial District: regular sessions shall
be held at Juneau, Ketchikan and Sitka.

(2) Second Judicial District: regular sessions shall
be held at Nome. Sessions shall also be held at
Kotzebue and Barrow as ordered by the presiding judge.

(3) Third Judicial District: regular sessions shall
be held at Anchorage, Kenai and Kodiak.

(4) Fourth Judicial District: regular sessions shall
be held at Fairbanks.

(b) Special Sessions. Special sessions shall be held
in each judicial district as ordered by the presiding
judge of that judicial district and at such other times
and places as he may prescribe. Special sessions shall

also be held at such other times and places as may be prescribed by order of the chief justice after appropriate notice.
