ORDER NO. 124

Amending Rule 20
Rules of Administration

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Rule 20, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts, is amended as follows:

(1) That the title of said rule is amended to read as follows:

Rule 20. Jurors--Predetermination of Qualifications--
Service of Summons--Selection of Jury Panel

(2) That the following new provision is added as sub-division (e) of said rule:

(e) As an alternative to the procedure authorized under AS 09.20.060-09.20.070 for the selection of jury panels, the presiding judge of the superior court in each judicial district may direct that jury panels be chosen by use of random computer selection. Where computer selection is utilized, it shall be in accordance with such guidelines as are promulgated by the administrator of courts, and it shall be conducted under the supervision of such officer as shall be designated by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.
