ORDER NO. 174

Amending Rule 17
Rules of Administration

IT IS ORDERED:

The Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts
are amended as set out below:

Rule 17, Rules Governing the Administration of All
Courts is modified to read as follows:

Rule 17(a) - Petit jurors summoned, who qualify for service on the venire, shall be paid at the rate of \$15.00 per day for every full day spent as a member of the venire and \$7.50 for a half day or less spent as a member of the venire, except that petit jurors who can without inconvenience return to their homes each evening, shall receive such payment only for the days actually required to report to the court or while serving as a member of a panel. Except as otherwise directed by the supreme court, citizens selected for jury service in cities with a population in excess of 5,000 shall not be required to serve for a period longer than 30 consecutive days. In cities with a population less than 5,000, jury service shall be for 90 consecutive days with court attendance not to exceed 30 full calendar days. In communities with a population less than 2,500, jury service may be for one year but in no event shall court attendance exceed 30 full calendar days.

All jurors who commence sitting in a trial within the 30 day, 90 day, or one year period shall continue to serve in that matter until discharged by the trial court.
