## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 1875 (AMENDED)

Amending SCO 1875 to address court closure on a full or partial weekday for time computation; continuing temporary order allowing any filing that is due on a day that the court is closed for a full day or partial day to be timely filed on the next business day. Affected rules include Civil Rule 6(a), Criminal Rule 40(a), and Appellate Rule 502(a).

## **IT IS ORDERED:**

Supreme Court Order 1875 is amended as follows:

Civil Rule 6(a), Criminal Rule 40(a), and Appellate Rule 502(a) are amended on a temporary basis as follows:

Any filing that is due on a day that the court is closed for either a full day or a partial day will be considered timely filed if it is filed by close of business on the next regular business day. <u>Any day the court is closed</u> for a full weekday or partial weekday will be considered a "legal holiday" for the purposes of time computation.
