ORDER NO. 1894

Amending Administrative Rule 17.5(b) concerning the location of the office of the court of appeals and of court of appeals judges; and providing that a court of appeals judge may maintain an office in Anchorage, Juneau, or Fairbanks.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Administrative Rule 17.5(b) is amended to read as follows:

Rule 17.5. Sessions and Offices of the Court of Appeals.

* * * *

(b) **Office.** The principal office of the court of appeals shall be at Anchorage, Alaska. A court of appeals judge may maintain an office at a place other than the principal office as designated by order of the supreme court or of the chief justice.

* * * *

2. Pursuant to Administrative Rule 17.5(b), a court of appeals judge may maintain an office in Anchorage, Juneau, or Fairbanks.
