ORDER NO. 192

Amending Rule 10, Rules
Governing the Administra-
tion of All Court.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 10, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts,
is amended to read as follows:

Rule 10. PHYSICIANS' FEES.


Physicians shall be allowed a fee not to
exceed \$50.00 per hour for performing the
following services:

- (a) An examination under order of court
pursuant to AS 47.30.070, an autopsy
or post mortem examination under order
of the coroner pursuant to AS 12.65.020,
or such other examination as may be or-
dered by the court upon its own motion;
- (b) Giving medical expert testimony at a
hearing when ordered by the court in
relation to such examination.


Fees for such services shall be paid from funds
appropriated to the judiciary. Claims for com-
pensation shall be submitted on forms to be pro-
vided by the court and shall be submitted for
approval to the judicial officer ordering the
examination or testimony, subject to final appro-
val by the Administrative Director. In all other
cases, physicians' fees shall be paid by the re-
questing party or parties.


