## **IT IS ORDERED:**

Criminal Rule 5 is amended to read as follows:

## Rule 5. Proceedings Before the Judicial Officer.

## (a) Appearance Before Judicial Officer After Arrest.

(1) Except when the person arrested is issued a citation for a class C felony, misdemeanor, or a violation and immediately thereafter released, the arrested person shall appear before a judicial officer without unnecessary delay and in any event within 2448 hours after arrest, <u>absent compelling circumstances</u>, including weekend days and holidays.
