Temporary Waiver to Practice Law for Bar Exam Applicants Working under AS 08.08.210(d).

Based on the current public health emergency arising from COVID-19, rescheduling of the bar examination from July to fall 2020 due to COVID-19, and consultation with the Alaska Bar Association Board of Governors,

IT IS ORDERED:

A bar applicant currently practicing law under AS 08.08.210(d) who has registered for and takes the fall 2020 Alaska bar examination and whose 10-month period expires before the examination results are released may continue practicing law pursuant to this order for two weeks after the Alaska Bar Association releases the results, unless the applicant fails the examination. If the applicant fails the fall 2020 bar examination, the applicant's authority to practice will cease immediately upon release of the results.

An applicant who passes the bar examination shall comply with Bar Rule 5 to continue practicing beyond the two weeks permitted by this order.
