ORDER NO. 222

Amending Rule 30, Rules
of Criminal Procedure.

IT IS ORDERED:

I. Paragraph (a) of Rule 30, Rules of Criminal Procedure, is amended by adding the following after the language "but the court shall instruct the jury after the arguments are completed":

Additionally, the court in its discretion may give the jury such instructions it deems necessary, at any stage of the trial.

II. Paragraph (b) of Rule 30, Rules of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Instructions to be Given. The court shall instruct the jury on all matters of law which it considers necessary for the jury's information in giving their verdict.
