Rule 41.1 is added to the Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts, to read as follows:

Rule 41.1.

Duties of a Magistrate in location where either a District Court Judge or a Superior Court Judge regularly presides.

In any judicial location where either a District Court Judge or a Superior Court Judge, or both, regularly sit a Magistrate may not conduct any judicial proceedings except to hear bail matters, conduct arraignments in criminal proceedings, or act as a master. This general prohibition is not applicable when all judges at that location are actually presiding over other judicial proceedings, or are absent from duty because of vacation, sick leave, or temporary assignment to duty stations away from their permanent work location.

Specific exception can be made to this rule by order of the Supreme Court.
