ORDER NO. 238

Amending Rule 6.04,
Personnel Rules for
the Alaska Court System.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 6.04, Personnel Rules for the Alaska Court System, is amended to read:

6.04 Merit Increase

Merit increases shall be based upon the supervisor's evaluation of an employee's performance. A merit increase of one step in the salary range may be given to an employee who has received a performance evaluation of "acceptable" or better on his merit anniversary date. The sixteenth day of the month which coincides with the completion of his probationary period shall constitute an employee's merit anniversary date. No merit increases may place an employee at a higher salary level than the top step of his assigned salary range.

6.04.01 Unsatisfactory Work

The merit anniversary date does not change when a merit increase is withheld. If the employee's standard of performance reaches acceptable levels later in the merit year, the step

increase may be granted effective
the sixteenth of any month and
no change in the merit anniversary
date will result.
