Amending Rule 37, Part III,
Alaska Bar Rules.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 37, Part III, Alaska Bar Rules as adopted in Supreme Court Order No. 233, is amended by adding paragraphs (e) through (h), to read as follows:

- (e) Initially, the appointments of the six attorney members shall be: One regular and one alternate for one (1) year, one regular and one alternate for two (2) years, and one regular and one alternate for three (3) years. Thereafter, each appointment shall be for three years each.
- (f) The non-attorney members shall be appointed for three year terms.
- (g) The term of any member which expires while an arbitration is pending before him shall be extended until such arbitration is concluded, but such extension shall not prevent immediate appointment of his successor. The President shall appoint the chairman of each panel each year from among the regular panel members. The chairman shall vote except when an even number of panel members is sitting for the transaction of matters before the panel.

(h) If a member of a panel resigns prior to the expiration of his term, the President shall appoint a replacement to fill the unexpired term.
