Court of Alaska

IT IS ORDERED:

1. During the period of time and in the geographic area described below, all service of civil process and duties ancillary thereto under the Rules of Civil Procedure and applicable statutes shall be performed by private process servers appointed under Civil Rule 4(c)(3); provided that a member of the Alaska State Troopers or other peace officer may render assistance to a process server as provided in Civil Rule 4(c)(3).

2. Civil process under Paragraph 1 of this order includes any summons, subpoena, attachment, notice of execution following default judgment, execution, or other writ, in a civil action, and sales of property pursuant to writ, but does not include any process, civil or criminal, served on behalf of the State, or any department or agency thereof.

3. This order shall be in effect from November 1, 1976, through April 30, 1977, and covers civil process on persons and property within the boundaries of the Fairbanks North Star Borough.
