ORDER NO. 279

Amending Rule 36, Rules of Appellate Procedure, and relating to appellate review of Judicial Qualifications Commission proceedings involving a Supreme Court Justice.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 36, Rules of Appellate Procedure, is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(f) When the proceedings involve a supreme court justice, no justice may participate in the review, and the chief justice shall appoint a panel of superior court judges as justices pro tempore to review the proceedings. If the proceedings involve the chief justice, then the justice having the longest tenure on the supreme court who has not participated in the proceedings shall appoint the panel.
