File a Return if Service of  
Process is not Effected

IT IS ORDERED:


Paragraph (f) of Rule 4, Rules of Civil Procedure  
is amended to read:

(f) Return. The person serving the process shall make proof of service thereof to the court promptly and in any event during the time during which the person served must respond to the process. If service is made by a person other than a peace officer, he shall make affidavit thereof. Proof of service shall be in writing and shall set forth the manner, place, date of service, and all pleadings or other papers served with the process. Failure to make proof of service does not affect the validity of the service.


