ORDER NO. 307

Relating to the Alaska Bar
Association's Professional
Liability Insurance
Questionnaire

The Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association has advised this court that the Association is faced with a severe problem of diminishing markets for professional liability insurance and a correspondingly sharp increase in premiums for coverage that is still available. The primary cause thereof is the lack of valid statistics on the acts or omissions most frequently giving rise to claims. Because reliable claims experience data is essential to any effort to solve the problem,

IT IS ORDERED:

The court respectfully requests and directs each member of the Alaska Bar Association to respond by May 15, 1978 to a questionnaire to be distributed by the Association in a cooperative effort to solve said problem. Responses to the questionnaire shall be handled in such manner that the anonymity of the respondents is preserved.






