

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 308

Relating to the Commencement
of Criminal Cases Arising
Along the Pipeline Corridor
and Within the Barrow Judicial
Service Area

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Because that portion of the Barrow Judicial Service Area along the pipeline corridor is closely tied by transportation links to Fairbanks and in order to facilitate the orderly dispatch of judicial business within the Service Area, in criminal proceedings, if the offense was committed within the area described in this order as the "pipeline corridor," the case shall be commenced in Fairbanks.

2. In this order "pipeline corridor" means the area north of 69° latitude between 148° and 149° longitude, including all territorial waters of the state, and the area from 69° to 68° latitude between 148° and 150° longitude.
