Subsection (11) of paragraph (c) of Rule 24, Alaska Rules of
Criminal Procedure, is amended to read:


- (11) That the person within the previous two years:
- (i) has been a party adverse to the challenging party
or attorney in a civil action; or
 - (ii) has complained against or been accused by the
challenging party or attorney in a criminal pro-
secution.


