## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

## ORDER NO. 447

Two-part Order Amending Paragraph (m) of Rule 77, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, Relating to Motions for Reconsideration and Paragraph (d) of Rule 73, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, Relating to Notice of Orders or Judgments.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. As redesignated by Part 2 of Supreme Court Order No. 434, paragraph (m) of Rule 77, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

(m) A motion to reconsider the decision may be made within 10 days of the date that the decision has been entered and shall be governed by Rule 506, Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure, except otherwise provided herein. The motion for as reconsideration shall be decided by the court, without oral argument, within 10 days of the date of the filing of themotion. If the motion for reconsideration has not been ruled upon the court within 20 days from the date of the filing of the motion, it shall be taken as denied for the purposes of the record.

2. Paragraph (d) of Rule 73, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

(d) <u>Notice of Orders or Judgments</u>. Immediately upon the entry of an order or judgment the clerk shall serve a notice of the entry by mail in the manner provided for in Rule 5 upon each party who is not in default for failure to appear, and shall make a note in the docket of the mailing. Such mailing is sufficient notice for all purposes for which notice of the entry of an order is required by these rules; but any party may in addition serve a notice of such entry in the manner provided in Rule 5 for the service of papers. Lack of notice of the entry by the clerk does not affect the time to appeal or seek review or relieve or authorize the court to relieve a party for failure to appeal or seek review within the time allowed, except as permitted in Rule 204(a), Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure.
