IT IS ORDERED:

Paragraph (e) of Rule 7, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure,  
is amended to read:

(e) Amendment of Indictment or Information.  
[IF ANY ERROR IN FORM SHALL EXIST IN ANY  
INDICTMENT OR INFORMATION OR IN THE MANNER OF  
DESCRIBING THE OFFENSE, OF IF A DEFENDANT IS  
INDICTED BY A FICTITIOUS OR ERRONEOUS NAME AND  
AFTERWARDS HIS TRUE NAME IS DISCOVERED,] The  
court may permit [THE] an indictment or  
information to be amended at any time before  
verdict or finding if no additional or  
different offense is charged and the sub-  
stantial rights of the defendant are not  
prejudiced.
