Waiving The Bar Rule  
Confidentiality Requirements  
For Records Of Applicants Who  
Apply To Fill Judicial Vacanc.  
In The State of Alaska

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon the filing of an application to fill a judicial vacancy in the State of Alaska, and upon request to the Bar Association from the Judicial Council, the Bar Association shall provide to the Judicial Council copies of the following files for each attorney applicant:

(1) fee arbitration files, if any; (2) attorney discipline files, if any; and (3) the general attorney file.

2. The Judicial Council shall maintain confidentiality of all such records received from the Alaska Bar Association in accordance with the Bar Rules.
