Amending Appellate Rule 611(a),
relating to Petitions for Review

IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate Rule 611(a) is amended to read as follows:

(a) Filing.


A petition for review may be filed with the clerk of the superior court within ten days from the date of the challenged order or decision, along with proof of service on all parties. A judge of the superior court, for good cause shown, may extend the time for filing. The party seeking review shall be known as the petitioner. All other parties to the proceeding shall be named as respondents. When the petition arises from an administrative tribunal, a notice of appeal shall be filed with that body. [OTHERWISE, NO NOTICE OF REVIEW IS REQUIRED]. The clerk of the superior court shall proceed in accordance with Rule 403(a)(4).




