ORDER NO. 55

Amending Rule 67,
Rules of Civil
Procedure

IT IS ORDERED:

That Rule 67, Rules of Civil Procedure, be amended to read as follows:

"RULE 67. DEPOSIT IN COURT - COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS.

- (a) In an action in which any part of the relief sought is a judgment for a sum of money or the disposition of a sum of money or the disposition of any other thing capable of delivery, a party upon notice to every other party, and by leave of court, may deposit with the court all or any part of such sum or thing. Money paid into court under this order shall be deposited and withdrawn in accordance with the provisions of rules governing the administration of the courts.
- (b) In any action where payment of moneys for purposes of child support is ordered, payment shall be made to a court trustee appointed by the presiding superior court judge, unless another payment method is ordered by the court for cause. An order shall be entered which shall contain the following:
- (1) The names of the parties and of the children for whom support payments are ordered; the home addresses of the parties together with their mailing addresses, if different from their home addresses; and the name and address of the employer, if any, of the party ordered to make child support payments.
 - (2) A provision directing each party to inform the court trustee, in writing, of any change in his or her residence or mailing address within five days after any such change. The order shall also state the address of the court trustee.
 - (3) A provision directing transmittal of a copy of the order to each party to the action and to the court trustee.

Fees for collection and distribution of child support payments shall be as established by the administrative director."
