IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 11, paragraph (a), subparagraph (1) of the Rule Governing
Administrator of All Courts is amended to read:

(1) Service of Process:

(i) For service of any summons or subpoena--each person on whom
service is made \$22.50


(ii) For service of any warrant, attachment, notice of levy, intent to
levy or garnishment, execution or other writ--each person on whom
service is made \$22.50


(iii) For each hour in excess of two actually and necessarily spent to
obtain service under (i) or (ii) above \$12.50


(iv) If more than one document involving the same case is given to the
same individual at the same time, only one fee shall be charged.




