

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 59

Establishing a revised fee schedule for all courts; amending Rules 11, 14, 16 and 54, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts; amending Rules 9(m) and 26(b), Rules of the Supreme Court of Alaska; rescinding Supreme Court Order No. 13; and amending Supreme Court Order No. 19.

IT IS ORDERED:

That fees as specified in the annexed schedule be charged for services by the courts as designated therein;

That the Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts and the Rules of the Supreme Court of Alaska are amended as follows:

Rule 11, Rules Governing the Administration of

All Courts: Is amended to read as follows:

"The clerk shall file an action or proceeding upon the payment of the filing fee prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59. Further or additional fees or charges shall be made by the clerk with respect to such action or proceeding only for additional services as specified in the schedule of fees, except that actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the clerk, such as postage, shall also be paid by a party."

Rule 14, Rules Governing the Administration of

All Courts: Is amended to read as follows:

"The clerk of the superior court shall file and docket an appeal from a magistrate court upon the payment of the filing fee prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59, except in forma pauperis cases."

Rule 16, Rules Governing the Administration of

All Courts: Is amended to read as follows:

"Clerks of court or magistrates shall charge such fees for incidental service performed as are prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59."

Rule 54, Rules Governing the Administration of

All Courts: Is amended to read as follows:

"Except as otherwise provided in these rules, the fees for all services rendered and functions performed by district and deputy magistrates shall be as prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59."

Rule 9(m), Rules of the Supreme Court of Alaska:

Is amended to read as follows:

"(m) Filing Fee. Immediately after a notice of appeal is filed, the appellant shall pay to the clerk of this court a filing fee prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59."

Rule 26(b), Rules of the Supreme Court of Alaska:

Is amended to read as follows:

"(b) Filing Fee. Upon the filing of the petition, counsel for the petitioner shall enter his appearance and pay a filing fee prescribed in the schedule of fees by Supreme Court Order No. 59."

That Order No. 13, dated January 18, 1960, establishing fees to be charged by the superior court, is rescinded; and

That Order No. 19, relating to fees and costs in cases arising under the Uniform Reciprocal Enforcement of Support Act (AS 25.25), is amended by deleting the third (final) paragraph therefrom.
