ORDER NO. 603

Correcting Technical Error in
Criminal Rule 32(e)(4),
relating to a three-judge
sentencing panel.

IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 32(e)(4) is amended to read as follows:

(4) Both the prosecuting attorney and the defendant may exercise in a timely fashion a challenge for cause, or a peremptory challenge if not previously exercised, to one judge on the sentencing panel in accordance with A.S. 22.20.022 and Rule 25(d)(1), Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure. In the event that a judge on the sentencing panel is the same judge who made the finding under subsection (1) of this rule, that judge shall be automatically disqualified.


