IT IS ORDERED:


The second sentence of Rule 35(a) of the Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure is amended to read as follows:

"The court may reduce a sentence within 120 days after sentence is imposed, or within 120 days after the effective date of the judgment or receipt by the court of an order of dismissal of the appeal, or within 120 days after receipt of an order of the supreme court of the state or of the United States denying an application for relief."


