IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate Rule 212(a)(2) is amended to provide:


(2) Number of Copies. A single copy of each brief accompanied by proof of service must be filed with the clerk on or before the date the brief is due. Except as provided in (a)(3) of this rule, the brief will be reviewed and returned to counsel for duplication and binding. Within ten days thereafter, 15 copies of each duplicated brief in civil appeals must be filed with the clerk and two copies shall be served on each party. Except as provided in (a)(3) of this rule, 13 copies of each duplicated brief in criminal cases must be filed with the clerk and two copies shall be served on each party. The clerk may specify a different number of copies than required by this rule.




