challenge of judge.


IT IS ORDERED:


Criminal Rule 25(d)(5) is amended to provide:


(5) Waiver. A party loses the right under this rule to change a judge when the party, after a reasonable opportunity to consult with counsel, agrees to the assignment of the case to the judge or, knowing that the judge has been permanently assigned to the case, participates before the judge in an omnibus hearing, any subsequent pretrial hearing, a hearing under Rule 11, or the commencement of trial. No provision of this rule shall bar a stipulation as to the judge before whom a plea of guilty or of nolo contendere shall be taken under Rule 11.


