IT IS ORDERED:







Justice Rabinowitz, dissenting.

I dissent. Appellate Rule 604(a) provides in part that "Unless otherwise ordered by the superior court, the record on appeal shall be prepared in conformity with Rule 210" In my view, Order No. 1 is authorized by this provision. Thus, I could not disapprove the order.

I note that it remains open to the superior court in the individual case to enter an order similar in effect to Order No. 1, pursuant to Appellate Rule 604(a).
