concerning designation of
record in sentence appeals to
superior court.

IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate Rule 608 is amended to provide:

A sentence appeal to the superior court is [SHALL BE] governed by Rule 215. [AND] That rule will [SHALL] in case of inconsistency prevail over Part Six of these rules, except that as provided by Rule 604(a) the record on appeal consists of the entire district court record and designation of the record is not required.
