
IT IS ORDERED:


Criminal Rule 6(f) is amended to provide:


(f) Objections to Grand Jury and to Grand Jurors. A motion to dismiss the indictment may be based upon objections to the array or the lack of legal qualification of an individual juror. An indictment shall not be dismissed upon the ground that one or more members of the grand jury were not legally qualified if it appears from the record kept pursuant to section (j) of this rule that a majority of the total number of grand jurors, after deducting the number not legally qualified, concurred in finding the indictment.




