

**UNCONTESTED DIVORCE
W/ Kids & Paternity Issues & NO Property**

1. If both spouses agree:
- to end the marriage
 - to the parenting plan for any children from both parents, AND
 - to disestablish paternity of the husband for any children born from a different father

they can fill out the following forms:

SHC-520 Word PDF	Finding of Fact and Conclusions of Law (Note: this form does not specifically address paternity issues so must use "Other" section)	1 for both (parties DO NOT sign)
SHC-525 Word PDF	Decree and Judgment (Note: this form does not specifically address paternity issues so must use "Other" section)	1 for both (parties DO NOT sign)

Optional Forms Depending on the Situation

DR-306	Shared Custody Child Support Calculation	1 form signed by both parties
SHC-1340 Word PDF SHC-1341 Word PDF	Motion & Affidavit to Appear by Telephone Order on Motion to Appear by Telephone	1 form from party who wants to testify by phone
SHC-151 Word PDF	Three-Way Affidavit of Paternity	1 form signed by wife, husband and biological father

Mandatory Information required by Judge

- Tax return, most recent unless judge asks for more
 - Current pay stubs for last 2 months
 - If you are disestablishing paternity you must show clear and convincing evidence to the Judge that you are not the parent. For example:
 - DNA Testing results
 - 3 way affidavit signed by wife, husband and biological father
2. Make 2 copies of all filled-out forms and save for each spouse's records.
 3. File the filled-out and signed forms at the court. A court employee can notarize the affidavits for free.
 4. The court will give you a Domestic Relations Procedural Order when you file. This document is the first Order from the judge. Please read it carefully.
 5. Wait for the judge to schedule a hearing. You will be notified by mail of the date.
