AMENDED ORDER VACATING PRESIDING JUDGES' STATEWIDE STANDING ORDER GOVERNING SB 91 TECHNICAL PETITIONS TO REVOKE PROBATION

On January 7, 2017, the Presiding Judges adopted an order establishing procedures for processing technical felony Petitions to Revoke Probation necessitated by SB 91, the Omnibus Criminal Law and Procedures Act. But in 2019, much of SB 91 was repealed with the passage of HB 49, including the notion of "technical violations." Accordingly, the 2017 Presiding Judges' Statewide Standing Order Governing SB91 Technical Petitions to Revoke Probation is vacated.
